BEHAVIOR GUIDELINES

PLEASE READ OUR BEHAVIOR POLICY WITH YOUR CAMPER BEFORE CAMP.

WE ALWAYS EXPECT CAMPERS TO BE RESPECTFUL, WHEN ON OUR PROPERTY OR PARTICIPATING IN OUR PROGRAMS. CAMPERS ARE TO BEHAVE IN A PLEASANT, RESPONSIBLE WAY AND RESPECT THE RIGHTS AND DIGNITY OF OTHERS:

- CAMPERS TAKE **RESPONSIBILITY** FOR THEIR ACTIONS.
- CAMPERS **RESPECT** THEMSELVES, EACH OTHER, CAMP EQUIPMENT, AND THE ENVIRONMENT.
- **HONESTY** WILL BE THE BASIS FOR ALL RELATIONSHIPS AND INTERACTIONS.
- CAMPERS WILL BE **CARING** IN THEIR RELATIONSHIPS WITH OTHERS.

CAMPERS SHOULD TALK TO ANY CAMP STAFF MEMBER IF THEY ARE UNCOMFORTABLE WITH ANY EXPERIENCES OR NEED ASSISTANCE WHILE AT CAMP.

DISCIPLINE PROCEDURES

WHEN A CAMPER FAILS TO ADHERE TO BEHAVIOR GUIDELINES, THE FOLLOWING STEPS WILL BE TAKEN TO ENSURE BEHAVIOR ISSUES DO NOT FURTHER ESCALATE:

1. CAMP STAFF WILL GUIDE THE CAMPER TOWARDS MORE APPROPRIATE BEHAVIOR.
2. IF INAPPROPRIATE BEHAVIOR PERSISTS, THE CAMPER WILL BE REMINDED OF BEHAVIOR GUIDELINES AND CAMP RULES AND ASKED TO CHOOSE CORRECTIVE ACTIONS.
3. IF THE CHILD'S BEHAVIOR CONTINUES TO DISRUPT OTHERS AND DOES NOT MEET EXPECTATIONS, THEY WILL MISS THE NEXT SCHEDULED CAMP DAY.
4. IN CASE OF ONGOING INAPPROPRIATE BEHAVIOR, THE CAMPER MAY BE DISMISSED FROM CAMP FOR A PERIOD DETERMINED BY THE CAMP STAFF (RANGING FROM ONE CAMP DAY TO THE REST OF THE SUMMER).

EXAMPLES OF UNACCEPTABLE BEHAVIOR:

- DISOBEYING BEHAVIOR GUIDELINES OR CAMP RULES
- ENGAGING IN PROFANITY, VULGARITY, OR OBSCENITY
- THEFT OR PROPERTY DAMAGE
- NON-PARTICIPATION IN ACTIVITIES OR REFUSAL TO COOPERATE WITH STAFF
- DISRUPTION OF PROGRAMS
- LEAVING THE GROUP WITHOUT PERMISSION
- ENDANGERING OWN OR OTHERS' HEALTH AND SAFETY, INCLUDING STAFF
- USE OF DRUGS, ALCOHOL, TOBACCO, OR ENGAGING IN SEXUAL CONDUCT
- TEASING, BULLYING, OR FIGHTING WITH OTHER CAMPERS OR STAFF

SUMMER CAMP FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE. DISMISSAL DUE TO DISCIPLINARY REASONS, PHYSICAL VIOLENCE, OR BULLYING WILL LEAD TO IMMEDIATE REMOVAL FROM THE CAMP PROGRAM.

CAMPERS MUST FULFILL THE CODE OF CONDUCT, SUBMIT REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION, AND CLEAR TUITION ACCOUNTS TO BE ACCEPTED.

TUITION EXPRESS ACCOUNTS MUST BE MAINTAINED TO CONTINUE ENROLLMENT.

WITHDRAWAL FOR ANY REASON WILL REQUIRE IMMEDIATE PAYMENT OF OUTSTANDING BALANCES.
